**Eligibility:** Graduating high school senior, child or legal dependant of an active, retired or deceased U.S. military service member whose family resides at West Point (or within a 35 mile radius of West Point) at the time the scholarship is awarded.

Selection of applicants will be governed by both Academics and Citizenship.

**Academics:** Applicants shall have taken the Standard Achievement Tests of the College Entrance Examination Boards (SAT) or American College Tests (ACT) and shall have at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average.

**Citizenship:** Citizenship is interpreted as meaning attitude, conduct, cooperation and participation in extracurricular activities in the local community to include school, church or civic organizations.

Scholarship funds are intended to pay for tuition, books, and fees for degree programs at accredited institutions of higher learning.

Scholarships will not be awarded to applicants who receive an appointment to one of the service academies and their affiliated preparatory schools, any ROTC scholarship award, any overseas programs, special programs, fully funded programs or an applicant who has received any other full scholarships at an accredited U.S. post-secondary institution of higher education.

Judging is done anonymously. Committee members and applicants' names will not be divulged. DUSA Scholarship Chair will notify scholarship winners. Funds will be dispersed in the fall after scholarship winners provide proof of enrollment by submitting payment information from his/her school. Scholarship award will be mailed directly to the school.

Term of scholarship is for one year and must be used in the academic year in which it is awarded. No deferments will be granted.

Applications must be complete upon submission. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Please place in one manila envelope: Completed Application Form; Official High School Transcript; Photocopy of any college acceptance letters; Photocopy of Test Scores (SAT, ACT, Other); Photocopy of Military Identification Card, front and back; Two Letters of Reference; Essays
